ORDINANCE NO. 03-08

AN AMENDMENT TO THE WEST BRANDYWINE TOWNSHIP CODE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTERS 1 AND 155 DEALING WITH SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING

Be it ordained by and on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, West Brandywine Township, that the West Brandywine Township Code, shall be and hereby is amended as follows:

Amend the following term in Section 1-20 to read as follows: Bulk Waste Pickup-limited to one item of bulk waste or an additional combination of two 33 gallon containers or bags.

Amend Section 155-3.A.(1)(a) to read as follows: Three 33 gallon containers, bags or combination thereof, not weighing more than 70 pounds each.

Delete Sections 155-3.A.(1)(b)(c)

Amend Section 155-3.A.(6) to read as follows: All refuse containers, bags or combination thereof shall be securely closed and placed at curbside by 5:00 a.m. on days designated by the Township for collection. At no time shall any solid waste be placed at curbside more than twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the designated collection day, nor shall any cans remain at the curbside for more than twenty-four (24) hours after the designated collection day. Containers shall be placed as close to the roadway as practicable without interfering with or endangering the movement of vehicles or pedestrians including sight obstruction.

Amend Section 155-3.B. to read as follows: The Board of Supervisors shall provide the opportunity for each residence to place a bulk item out at curbside on any given collection day as further defined in the definition of bulk waste pickup.

Amend Section 155-17.A.(6) and C.(6) to read as follows: Newspaper


Add Section 155-17.A.(7) and C.(7) to read as follows: The following paper products may be dropped off at the Township building for recycling.




