

**WEST BRANDYWINE TOWNSHIP
OPEN SPACE REVIEW BOARD
MEETING MINUTES OF MARCH 26, 2010**

The West Brandywine Township Open space Review Board meeting of Thursday March 26, 2010 was called to order at 6:56 p.m.

Members in attendance were John Cassels, Jeff Chalfant, Chuck Dobson, Anita Ferenz, Kim Hoopes, Steve Jakatt and Bob Schini.

Action on Minutes of Previous Meeting

Acceptance of January 28, 2010 minutes. Kim Hoopes motioned to accept the minutes of January 28, 2010. Anita Ferenz seconded the motion. All members who were in attendance voted in favor of the motion to accept the January minutes.

Public Attendance: No one present.

Old Business:

Icedale Meadows; An environmental grant for \$7,100 was applied for on March 22, 2010. It was noted that the existing trail needs maintenance work, possibly a load of chips for “filler”. It was suggested that volunteers be solicited to assist with this project. It was also noted that the dam removal will require a grant for the purpose of engineering duties.

Chase Property; In receipt of revised proposal, waiting for a response.

Baldwin Property; The Baldwin’s are going to move forward with the proposal but have made it clear that walking/hiking trails are not part of the plan. It was suggested that Ron Rambo feel them out in regards to being amenable to restoring the springhouse located on the property.

Baker Road Property; The property has been surveyed and a meeting between Carl Lindborg and Ron Rambo is tentative to discuss payment options. In addition, an easement for a trail on the South and West portion (“Old road”) is being worked on.

Dr. Eck Property; As was previously requested, Dr. Eck was scheduled to appear but did not show nor notify as to a reason. Ron Rambo will contact George Harlan to further gain information.

Steve Jackatt who was nominated to take over as committee chairperson at the January 28, 2010 meeting, informed everyone present that he does not want to assume the chairmanship. It was also suggested that Ron Rambo research the initial requirements in regards to the OSRB make up. The feeling being that a broader composition of township residents could at this stage, after the establishment of the current guidelines, provide a more overall perspective. It was also suggested that perhaps the OSRB committee incorporate a revolving chairperson so that the duties are distributed more evenly. It was left that we would wait and see what information Ron Rambo is able to gather as to how we will proceed.
