**Local Service Tax (LST):** The Local Services Tax is \$52 per year. Coatesville Area School District receives .5% of it.

**Earned Income Tax (EIT) -** The EIT for Township residents is 1.125% . Of this, .5% goes to the School District, .5% goes to the Township's General Operating Fund, and .125% to the Township's Open Space Reserve Fund. This fund is to be utilized for the purchase of open space, conservation easements, and the transfer of development rights. For non-residents, Earned Income Tax is 1% of which .5% goes to the employee's School District and .5% goes to the Township's General Operating Fund.

## SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

<p><b>YARD WASTE RECYCLING DROP-OFF HOURS</b></p> <p><b>199 Lafayette Rd. Maintenance Facility Building</b></p> <p>Yard Waste Drop Off Trimmings can be dropped off at the Public Works Facility. Residents may drop off yard waste throughout the year on the first Saturday of the month, 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. or the third Wednesday of the month from March through October from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. This service is to provide a convenience to our residents as an outlet for yard debris. Please consult professionals for tree removal services.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Free wood chips are available for residents at the old Township Building.</i></p>	<p>Storage and Collection: The storage and collection of all residential refuse from residential units shall comply with the following.</p> <p>All residential refuse, <b>except tree trimmings, grass cuttings, dead plants, weeds, leaves and dead trees or branches</b>, (NO YARD WASTE) must be securely contained as follows:</p> <p>Three (3) thirty-gallon containers, bags or combination thereof, not weighing more than seventy (70) pounds each.</p> <p>All refuse containers, bags or combination thereof shall be securely closed and placed at curbside by 5:00 a.m. on Thursday. At no time shall any solid waste be placed at curbside more than 24 hours in advance of the collection day, nor shall any cans remain at the curbside for more than 24 hours after the designated collection day.</p>
