

**Reverse 911 Emergency Management Broadcast
Hurricane Sandy**

This is an emergency notification from the West Brandywine Township Board of Supervisors.

An emergency has been declared By West Brandywine Township starting at 7:00 AM Monday morning, extending through the duration of Hurricane Sandy.

Hurricane Sandy is expected to bring sustained high winds and an estimated 8 to 12 inches of rain starting Monday morning extending through Wednesday. Hurricane force winds may be experienced starting early Tuesday morning through Tuesday afternoon.

Residents of West Brandywine Township are being asked to refrain from traveling on township roads unless absolutely necessary. Previous experience with storms like Sandy indicates a high risk for scattered debris, fallen trees and downed wires. Routes need to be open for emergency response personnel and vehicles.

Residents are encouraged to review their emergency preparedness plan; to have enough water and nonperishable food, extra batteries and warm clothes. Residents should be prepared for possible power outages. If you have special needs, please register at www.specialneedspea.org
